Community Services and Supports

Supported Community Living (SCL) addresses the dreams, desires, goals, strengths, abilities, needs, health, safety and life span issues of the member. Services may be in the family home, their own home or in a community setting. One to twenty-four hours of support per day are based on the individuals needs.

Consumer Directed Attendant Care (CDAC)

Assistance to the member with self-care tasks, which the member would typically do independently if he/she were otherwise able.
